#### **Shipping condition**

- You will arrive in Canada or you have stayed in Canada up to 6 month from departure.
- · You need to make import customs clearance up to one year from arrival.
- We can't accept to make import customs clearance before your arrival.
- If you are Canadian Citizen, you need to stay in Japan at least 1 year before departure with residence card("Zairyu Card").
- If you are not Canadian Citizen, you have obtained Canadian Visa(except Visitor Visa) or PR Card.
- You need to submit Canadian Customs Form "B4-E" with packing list when entering Canada.
  - \* Please download the Form "B4-E" from the website of Canada Border Services Agency, and fill out the form before departure from Japan.

  - st If you will stay in Canada with working visa or study visa, you do not need the Form " B4-E ".
- You need to go to the customs office in Toronto(Pearson) Airport and make customs clearance with yourself after the shipment's arrival at Toronto.




## The flow of procedure

- \* Notice: You need to declare to Customs that you have unaccompanied goods by Declaration Card. Please do not forget to mark "Yes" on question "I/We have unaccompanied goods" on the card.
  - 1) Pick up your shipment : Please fill out the Customs Form "B4-E" before departure from Japan.
  - 2) At the arrival airport: Please submit the Customs Form "B4-E" and packing list to customs officer and get stamps on them.
  - 3) Also the customs officer gives you "ACCOUNTING DOCUMENT". These 3 documents are required when you go to the Customs Office for import customs clearance.
